SUCCULENTICON 2018

28 SEPTEMBER TO 1 OCTOBER

You are invited to Succulenticon 2018 in Perth, Western Australia. The convention will be over four days, 28 September to 1 October, with talks and garden visits on Saturday, Sunday and Monday, and an excursion, registration, sales, and welcome refreshments on Friday.

The Saturday will consist of final registrations, sales, and talks, with a dinner and auction in the evening. Sunday will consist of sales and garden visits, with participants picked up by coach from the hotel and taken to a number of sites over the day, then returned to the hotel for dinner. Monday will again have sales and talks, with a closing function in the evening.

The Tuesday will be available for privately arranged garden visits. Transport may also be organised on this day if the demand warrants (this may be on a cost-share basis - this will be determined closer to the convention).

Full Registration provides access to all aspects of the convention (except the Friday excursion, which is separately charged), morning and afternoon tea, lunch and dinner on Saturday, Sunday, and Monday.

Day Registration is also provided for each of Saturday and Monday, and gives access to sales and talks for the respective day for which registered, as well as morning and afternoon tea, and lunch (but not evening meals for those days, or the Saturday auction).

Partners - there are a number of convention functions that have been separately costed for partners and others who are not attending the rest of the convention - these are shown on the Registration Form.

Friday Excursion - The pre-convention excursion has been designed to showcase both our unique wildflowers and Kings Park. Participants will be picked up by bus from the hotel around 9:00am, in time to arrive at Kings Park for a visit to the world-class Aspects of Kings Park gallery, followed by a 1.5 to 2 hour botanical ramble through the park with a dedicated guide, picked up again and taken to the Zamia Cafe for a two-course set lunch (choice of two hot meals, desert, tea/coffee), and then taken back to the hotel in time to get cleaned up for Registration in the evening. The cost has been subsidised to keep it at a very reasonable \$50.

VENUE

The Metro Hotel in South Perth, the site of the successful 2013 Perth Get Together, has again been chosen as the venue. Its convention facilities and rooms have since been refurbished, and the hotel has provided some very competitive rates for those attending Succulenticon 2018. These are:

Standard Room: \$129 per night
Superior Room: \$149 per night
Aspire Executive Room: \$169 per night
Full Breakfast at \$20 per person, per day

The Metro Hotel is situated at 61 Canning Highway, South Perth, quite close to the Perth CBD, and overlooks the beautiful Swan River. Free parking is available for attendees. Contact details are as follows:

A number of CSSWA members will be available as hosts by arrangement for outings and private garden visits. Optional garden visits are also being arranged for the Tuesday (and perhaps Wednesday - to be notified) after the convention - depending on the response, transport will be by private vehicles, or by mini bus (may be cost share). The gardens concerned are exceptionally worthwhile, but require a whole day due to their distance of most from Perth.
